

DEREK WATSON SETS RECORDS To Win TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP!

PLUS 2'S MAKE STRONG RUN, PREPARE FOR 2007 SERIES!

Ernie Couse and Brandon Collier, Win Points And Money Championships!

Ernie Couse, of Neptune Beach, Fla, played steady golf all year and won the Points Championship for \$3,000 barely beating out **Bill Currence** of Deltona, Fla. by nine points. Ernie had eight top ten finishes with a second at Eagle Eye in Michigan. Bill led most of the second half of the year when he came on with a victory in the IGTA Open Championship at Eagle Eye and then a second in Atlanta and third in Chicago. He had seven top ten finishes.

Brandon Collier, Naples, Fla. was the leading money winner with \$17,475.00 with wins at Victoria Hills in DeLand and Mystery Valley in Atlanta. **Derek Watson**, of Myrtle Beach, S.C, was second with \$16,185.00 Derek won the Tour Championship, at The Florida Club in Stuart, setting **Tour Records - Gross 65/65 130 and Net 134.5**. Third on the Money List was **J.J. Campbell**, Florida, at \$14,950 **Robin Byrd**, N. Carolina at \$14,505 and **Justin Peters, Ed Halsell, Bill Currence**, over \$10,000.

Single Digits Lead, but Pro's gain in 2006!

The Single Digit Players increased their winnings by 3.1% while remaining 58.1% of total players. The 0 +3 went up 6% with 2% more. **A total of \$188,651 or 54.4** was paid to the 0.1- 9.9 handicaps, **\$109,888 or 31.7%** was paid to scratch to +3, **\$45,820 or 13.2%** paid to 10 - 19.9 and **\$2,285 or 0.7%** to 20+ handicaps.

The Pro's are playing more and did win nine times, however the wins were spread over eight players.

Needless to say, he had a great tournament starting with a 65 to become one of five to share the record low for the Tour after six years. He came back with another 65 for a record 130. Derek posted nine birdies in round 1 and seven more in round 2. His Net Score of 134.5 was also a Tour record by 2.5 strokes. The old record of 137 Net was set in 2002 by **Jeri Radtke** of Cape Coral. The prior low Gross was by **John Koskinen**, So. Miami with a 133 at Harmony Golf Preserve earlier this year. The other four carding 65's were **Jimmy Montecino** in 2003, and then **Greg Towne**, **Don Wright** and **John Koskinen**.

How Does the IGTA do it, Year after Year?

Players with Handicaps - Must submit verifiable info, ghin indexes, scorecards, etc. Most important they must provide references prior to playing.

Handicaps are maintained, 100%, under the USGA Handicap System. Equitable Stroke Control and Exceptional Tournament Scores are parts of the system. The IGTA System will adjust a handicap, for the round after the round, based on built-in scoring parameters. This protects the entire field. If a player has at least a fifteen IGTA tournament history, the player then could score as low as the low "plus handicap" nets, without being adjusted. This circumstance has never occurred to date.

Professionals, competitive on other Tours are usually started with a plus 2 handicap. Exceptions are extended for those working to improve their game, but have a higher scoring history and most often are striving to top the cut line. After establishing with the IGTA, the plus handicaps are adjusted to the nearest half stroke. This keeps them head to head, generally within a stroke, and also continues to equalize the field. The system works, as demonstrated by the success of these players.
