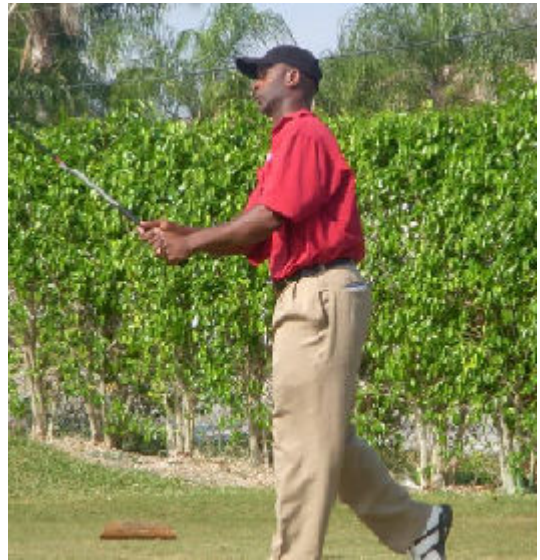


Don Wright Sets Money Records Wins \$33,307 to Lead the Tour!

Don Wright, Douglasville, Ga, took charge at **Legacy GC (67-66)** in Bradenton and went on for the best year ever for the IGTA Tour. Setting the single year record with \$33,307.50 he also extended his career earnings to over \$103,000.00. He had nineteen top-ten finishes in twenty-three events, including three wins with **Savannah Harbor** and **Whitewater Creek**. Don has now led the Tour three times, and is playing some of his best golf ever. This with a successful career, starring in the Million Dollar Challenge at Reunion in 2006 and challenging in the Big Stakes Ultimate Game in Mesquite, Nev. in 2005. Don played most events with a plus 3 to plus 4 handicap and always encouraged all levels of IGTA players.

Tour Shows Continued Strength in 2009!

The **2009 statistics** reflected strong play once again with plus handicaps jumping 4.5% riding Don Wright's record year. Single digits decreased their winnings by 7% with 53.8% of total players. **A total of \$145,335 or 51.2%** was paid to the 0.1- 9.9 handicaps, **\$78,729 or 27.7%** was paid to scratch to +3.5, the 10 - 19.9 group increased to **\$58,753 or 20.7%**, and **\$1,012 or 0.4%** paid to 20+ handicaps.

Majors Won by Stroble & Infantino

Bobby Stroble, Albany, Ga., returned to the IGTA after a three year hiatus. He recorded a fifth at Durham Lakes and then followed with a fine 74-73 at Cobblestone Park to win the **IGTA Open Championship** by 1 over **Dustin Cone** Bennington, Vt. and 1½ over **Chris Carr**, Duluth, Ga. **Bobby** has many accomplishments in his fine career, including Champions Tour winnings of over \$1.4 million, and a 9 hole score of 25 in Knoxville. After nearly being shut out in his first four tournaments, **Tony Infantino**, Coral Springs, came on strong in the final two majors. At Grande Pines, **Tony** shot -0.5 to nip **Don Wright** at even par and **Ken Jones**, at 1 over in the **Players Championship**. Then, at the Tradition Course at Reunion Resort, **Tony** posted +0.5 over par to win the **Tour Championship** by 1½ over **Carroll Carter**, So. Riding, Va. and by 2 over **Michael Goltz**, Winter Park, Fla. This was the First time a player has won two Majors in the same year.
